We find little evidence of crowd-out associated with the introduction of SCHIP. Extended parental coverage laws have minimal aggregate effects on coverage but they increase coverage by up to 5 percentage points for select groups. These laws may generate reverse crowd-out as individuals leave public insurance coverage to take advantage of the private coverage now available to them.
